

Bronchial Comparisons: A study of Antimonium Tartaricum (Ant T, Mineral), Coccus Cacti (Coc C, Parasitic Insect), Kali Bichromatum (Kali Bi, Mineral), and Lycopodium (Lyc, Plant)

Since the assessment and treatment of a patient with bronchial complaints still requires a total picture, it should be considered that there may be observable symptoms along the entire anatomical airway, the respiratory system, symptoms in the chest (and potentially the back), coughing characteristics, expectoration, nuances with fever, chills, and perspiration, and other signs/symptoms (not forgetting to include mind and generals) to help the observing homeopath assess the total state of the patient.¹

These four remedies share some common symptoms that bear noting. Patients requiring any one of these remedies may express symptoms of anxiety, dullness, or confusion, particularly in the morning. These remedies share susceptibility for alcoholism with a desire for alcoholic beverages which then aggravate (and there may be an accompanying aversion to tobacco, even if they are smokers (or if they partake in a 'customary' cigar!)). Their fevers are likely accompanied by profuse perspiration, and there may be a complaint that chills are aggravated after eating. These patients are ameliorated by rest and may even express laziness or a general sense of lassitude or internal heaviness. Cold air may both aggravate and ameliorate and they may state they feel better on becoming cold; in general any kind of heat, warmth, wraps, and/or clothing will aggravate. There can be aversion to food and drink, and there may be general aggravation for lying on the left side.

Nasal complaints may include discharge that is either viscous or watery, or the nasal passages can be dry and crusty. The breath may be offensive and the patient may complain of a bad taste in the mouth that is sweetish, metallic, or bitter with either dryness of the tongue or salivation. There can be swelling of the tongue. Patients may complain of painful burning in the mouth, throat, or esophagus, and there will be redness of the throat (while the tongue can appear white or brown). Swallowing will be difficult and will aggravate. There may be dryness, a painful sensation of scraping in the throat and larynx, or there can be production of viscous, tenacious mucous. The patient may have a weak voice, experience hoarseness (particularly in the morning), or can lose the voice entirely.

All four have a hacking, tickling, exhausting, rattling kind of cough that can be dry, loose, with expectoration (white or yellow with blood, copious, thick with mucous, tasting either sweet or salty), that is aggravated by lying down and by eating. Respiration is made difficult by the cough (which is described as short, barking, spasmodic, or suffocative) and may be either accelerated or arrested; the patient can experience this throughout the day, afternoon, and night. There is bronchial inflammation which can be either acute or chronic in nature (including asthmatic), and there can be a tickling kind of irritation in the larynx and trachea. There may be descriptions of constriction in the chest or pressing pains, and there can also be hemorrhage of the lungs due to tuberculosis (phthisis pulmonalis). All are common for whooping cough.

Accompanying the common symptoms are, of course, the unique expressions of these remedies that confirm not all bronchial problems are the same. To find these pictures, it helps to analyze each individually, particularly for single symptoms, SRPs, and rubrics appearing in bold type.²

In a patient requiring Ant T, mindset will alternate between indifference and cheerfulness and there may be expressions of fear related to health, the future, and the potential for dying (*that he may not recover and may suffocate in the night*). There is a fear of coughing and a fear of examination and of being

touched (*children with attention directed at them may go into convulsions*). In children and babies, there can be moaning, shrieking, and weeping prior to attack, with clinging and a desire to be carried upright. The Ant T patient may well present with the head tilted back and the neck outstretched (known as the 'sniffing' position³, this is common posturing for children who are experiencing difficulty breathing). The cough will be described as distracting, short, with a hissing sound that they may sleep through as though in a coma (described as *stupid sleep*); cough will generally be aggravated by talking. Stridor will be audible. In older patients, the cough may come every winter. In children, we can see very unique symptoms:

COUGH - JUMPING up - children; in - clinging to those around, calling for help in a hoarse voice; and - or bending backward and grasping at larynx.

And from Allen's Encyclopedia: He rubs his eyes with his hands as if in a stupid sleep and wakes in a very ill humor; if one looked at him he began to howl, *The child will not allow itself touched without whining and crying*, whereby the toes and fingers are drawn inwards.

There are underlying (and quite severe) pulmonary symptoms with Ant T (*worse on left side*). *Chest feels all the time very full*. Patients may complain of sensations in the chest as though the heart were rotating or revolving, that it has been sprained, or that it hurts as though strained. There will be inflammation of the bronchi with low fever, cold perspiration, and the patient may describe a velvety sensation in the chest; severe dyspnea. The chest can be very weak and the patient cannot expectorate; may gasp for air in order to cough. Patients may describe a knocking sensation as well. Face and lips can be cyanotic and the eyelids can appear as though covered in mucous. There may be a dusky, sooty appearance at the edge of the nostrils. There can be unconsciousness with ultimate suffocation as pulmonary edema, lung collapse (atelectasis), bronchiectasis (irreversible dilation of the bronchi), emphysema, and/or paralysis of the lung(s) may be present. In a severe situation, the patient will be highly anxious:

MIND - GESTURES, makes - hands; involuntary motions of the - grasping - bystanders, at

Patients may indicate that bending, turning, or stretching backwards ameliorates, as do eructations; aggravated by cold bathing, sitting, and bending forward. Cold air, walking about, and lying on right side ameliorates. Worse at night. Can be chilly, with cool, clammy skin. Worse in Autumn and Spring. Worse with milk. Irresistible thirst for cold water but vomits the smallest quantity taken⁴. Desire for sour drinks, acids, apples (extraordinary craving), which aggravate. Of the four remedies, the most noteworthy differential key to Ant T is the half-awake, half-asleep heavy-headed 'stupidity' and 'confusion of head' patients will demonstrate along with their bronchial symptoms. *Indicated for coughing when the child gets very angry, which is often. For children coughing who cannot expectorate; they become listless and drowsy, finally cyanotic. Rattling and rales.*

The Coc C patient may express symptoms of extreme irritation, as though a hair or a crumb were lodged in the back of the throat, or a hair hanging in the back of the throat. The cough is worse in the morning. *The child awakens and is immediately seized with a paroxysm of coughing ending in vomiting clear, ropy mucous hanging in long strings from the mouth*. There may be expressions of a plug of mucous hanging in the chest, or of mucous rising and falling in the trachea, or of something stuck behind the larynx. There is sensitivity to touch and to pressure, and rinsing the mouth or brushing the teeth will prompt more coughing and vomiting; conversely, rinsing the mouth with cold water may also ameliorate. Catarrh is worse with the slightest exposure, and aggravations are generally from autumn through the winter into spring. Redness at edge of nostrils and the tonsils may be swollen, accompanied by a continuous desire to swallow, as though something were lodged in the throat. There can be a sensation of the uvula being elongated which aggravates the cough (*constant hawking*) and the patient may have a hoarse, husky voice with fatigue of the vocal chords *even after speaking without exertion. Bronchial tubes loaded with*

³ In the United States, this posturing is taught to EMS personnel so they can recognize immediately that a child is having trouble with breathing. There may or may not be accompanying use of accessory muscles (a "sucking in" of muscles around the ribcage and abdomen). There may be slight chest movement and extraordinary use of abdominal muscles for breathing.

⁴ The vomiting action of antimony preparations is similar to that of Ipecac in that it is caused through the brain with direct stimulation of the pneumogastric nerves, rather than by aggravation within the stomach.

mucous. Can be a burning sensation under the sternum. Pains may be described as sticking, burning, or prickling. There can be an *irresistible urge to sleep* but the patient may wake frequently in the night with vivid dreams and *paroxysmal coughing*. Chilliness followed by general heat, with great perspiration that relieves.

In Kali Bi, we'll see diphtheric ropy, stringy, plastic, tenacious mucous that turns fibrous and tends to form a false membrane on mucous-producing surfaces. Its primary action is on the mucous membranes, according to Nash, and he includes not only all surfaces of the airway, but vaginal and uterine as well. *Mucous membranes will at first be violently inflamed with a great deal of redness and swelling with a production of excessive mucous, rapidly turning fibrous*. The membrane will be yellow looking, like "wash leather."⁵ There can be serious ulcerations. According to Farrington, the cough *has a decidedly metallic sound*, and we can see this confirmed in the single rubric *Cough, brassy*. There is after midnight aggravation with relief from sitting up and bending forward. Discharge of plugs, "klinkers." Will expectorate tough, fibrous casts looking like macaroni. The cough can be aggravated by cold, but is primarily aggravated by hot weather.

Lyc might seem a bit overwhelming on looking at the rubrics as there are so many, this being a well-known and well-tried polychrest. But if one looks particularly at the single and bold symptoms, a clear picture arises. We will see chiefly right-sided pain in the throat and chest. The nose may have crusts and plugs like Kali Bi, and the patient will have to breathe with the mouth. The cough will be deep and hollow sounding, and raising expectoration will bring little or no relief, or may relieve only for a short time. Expectoration can be any color and may have a foul odor which the patient describes as "Sulphur-like." Amelioration may come with warm food and drink, and the worst period of time will generally be from 4pm to 8pm. Cold air can both aggravate and ameliorate. There can be gurgling in the throat, with a sensation of a rising lump in the throat, and patient may complain of liquids being forced into their nose from the mouth. The cough will be tickling and is described as overpowering, as though the back of the throat and larynx are being tickled by a feather or as though there were dust in the throat. Cold food will aggravate and warm will ameliorate (except for oysters, which will aggravate!). Putting the tongue out will also aggravate, as will outstretching the arms. There will be inflammation of the bronchia and mucous can be profuse, white, yellow, gray, green, or rusty in color (yellow may be most common). There can be pain and constriction in the chest that is described as pressing, and this will be particularly aggravated by cold or open air. This remedy is known for COPD, lung cancer, tuberculosis, and other chronic lung conditions. The overall Lyc picture (little guy with tall fear) should be present.
