

Causticum – Anarchist “Rebel with a Cause” Born of Kali, Calcarea, and Sulphur

A count of the mind rubrics in Archibel Radar 9 yields the following results:

Causticum MIND Rubrics:	789
Calcarea Carbonica MIND rubrics:	1231
Kali Carbonica MIND Rubrics:	633
Sulphur MIND Rubrics:	1349

And an analysis of those rubrics yields the following commonalities among the remedies:

Causticum-Calcarea Common MIND Rubrics:	379
Causticum-Kali Carb Common MIND Rubrics:	254
Causticum-Sulphur Common Mind Rubrics:	378
Caust-Calc-KaliCarb-Sulph Common MIND Rubrics:	169

Although a remedy study is surely not simply a math problem, a few calculations can get us started and actually help produce some very interesting insights into these particular members of the mineral kingdom:

Causticum shares the MIND of (or is “under the influence of”) each remedy in the following percentages:

Causticum-Calcarea:	48.0% (379/789)
Causticum-Kali Carbonica:	32.2% (254/789)
Causticum-Sulphur:	47.9% (378/789)

A purely mathematical analysis would suggest that we should see stronger tendencies in the remedy to Calcarea- and Sulphur-like thinking/behaviors and sensations, influenced less heavily by Kali-C (and we shall see that this actually bears up when looking at the remedies’ comparative analyses.).

When we look at the total fully-shared rubrics (all three together with Causticum), we get the following results:

Calc-KaliCarb-Sulph:	21.4% (169/789)

Causticum has 789 MIND rubrics, which clearly indicates that although it is greatly influenced by the combination of these remedies, there is something else happening in the chemist’s crucible, resulting in a special synergistic affect that gives Causticum a unique mind – clearly one that it makes up on its own!

The shared MIND rubrics that can be considered to “bring out the ground-floor” of Casuticum (and indeed, the ground floor of Sulph/Kali-C/Caust) are highlighted in Table 1.

There is (in general terms) great agitation in the mind: a wide range of emotions, ailments from these, egotistical manifestations, and maniacal/delusional mental disturbances and fears may abound – taking form in the obstinate eccentricities and fancies of these kinds of patients.

When it comes to the common features, we can see the presence of a mind that gets fantastic ideas and gets quite carried away by them (to the point of “being beside oneself”).

Interestingly, although the specific details of these remedy minds do not come out in the common rubrics, the themes above *DO* combine together to make up the “baseline” of Causticum (our loveable “Anarchist”), building a foundation from which the unique mind and picture of this particular remedy develops, as we will shortly see.

In general, the common emotions and mind activities harass much of the day, as there are ailments and aggravations morning (on waking), evening, and during the night. From this ground floor view, it isn’t difficult to imagine Sulphur, Calc Carb, Kali C, or Caust eventually emerging!

It is obvious from these common rubrics that life might get to be pretty miserable or unfortunate-feeling for unhealthy members of this group. They go sleepless for the restlessness in their minds and they may be tormented in their sleep. They may be prone to alcoholism, weakness of will, eating disorders, kleptomania, and sexual indiscretions to compensate for the rushing-around in their heads and their inability to maintain a healthy and balanced existence. There are wild emotions that tend to change or swing about crazily. The mind is essentially caught up these basic polarity groupings:

Now that the foundational essence is clear, let's take a look at how these remedies come together in the form of the themes of Sulphur (idealism and relationship), Calcarea (protection of the home base), and Kali (correct but uptight) to create the essence of Causticum ("the Anarchist"). To do this, we have to return to the idea of mind-shares and look at how each

remedy influences or gives to the Causticum mind in a more specific way. In Table 2, we can see the analysis of the Causticum-Sulphur mind-share, or the “Idealistic Anarchist,” in which the all-remedy baseline rubrics have been removed – here we are looking for the more specific “sulphurisation” of the Causticum baseline:

With the baseline rubrics cleared away, it is very easy to see the Sulphur-influenced Causticum picture emerging (rubrics in blue are shared only between Sulphur and Causticum, black may be shared with Calc or Kali-C). The behaviors and moods deepen and develop towards dictatorship, fanaticism, religious affections, a sense of injustice – and the necessary enthusiasm and defiance to take a firm stand – albeit one that, in illness, may be steeped in delusions and carried-away ideas. We can see the emergence of relationships, cares for others, and more difficulties with others. We can see more serious behaviors potentially emerging from baseline: greed, spending, gambling, lewdness, and so forth – and along with the idea of justice and defiance, there may be greater wrong-doing (lying, stealing, hypocrisy) and a sense of this in the form of guilt, and/or remorse. In the low states, we can see the potential for greater confusion and prostration of the mind, more mistake-making, and a deepening of discontent to actual loathing of life and desire for death with suicidal tendencies.

But Causticum is not really like the entire Sulphurised image – Causticum is what we could call a “less-focused on the importance of the self” Sulphur, or a Sulphur less engaged in the lofty philosophies and ideas coupled with the typical arrogance and disdain of others – yet we can see the very specific Sulphur mind-properties coming into being to create the Anarchist.

We can now take a look at the Causticum-Calcareo “additive” to see what specifics come to the surface to interact with Sulphur in our Anarchist-in-the-Making. Again baseline rubrics will be removed to make it easier to see the “Protector of the Home Anarchist.” The rubrics unique to the Causticum-Calcareo and not shared by Sulph or Kali-C appear in blue text.

Here we can see the Calcarea home-and-family image emerging strongly, along with a Calcarea fears (in fact, the fears and anxieties show up dramatically in blue type), sadness, and more difficulty with the logical mind (mathematics in particular). Pile on fears, anxiety, more

worries about others, homesickness, and dashes of “Persecution Mania” with “Desire to Kill,” and suddenly we have the image of our anarchist, expecting the worst, convincing himself the world is against his cause, and one can imagine the rising feeling of hearth and home and the developing sense of urgency to protect and fight back.

With “Idealistic-Anarchist-Protector” in view, we look now to Kali-C to see how we get to the idea, as Misha states in the class lecture, “Wanting to Hit, But Cannot Hit.” This is where the Kali-C “correct but uptight” picture comes into play. The Idealistic-Protector wants to fight and to protect, to lead a revolution – but the Kali influence is to not. To be nice, to play fair, to follow the rules, as it were, to control and subdue in order to stay on the straight and narrow, because something bad could happen if you don’t. Here we can see the final nuances to flavor all previous descriptions, and the rubric “Anarchist” finally appears; there is secretive behavior, he is opinionated (rigid and dogmatic – correct but uptight), yet discontented with himself, fearful that something will happen, and tormented by persistent thoughts, preoccupied by a sense of duty (we can see some of this uptightness coming up in mind-stool difficulties here).

So, the Anarchist emerges and we can see Misha’s description more clearly now – “Wants to Hit, But Cannot Hit.” The wanting to strike out but trying to hold it back in creates the disturbance in Causticum related to rigidity and contraction of ligaments and tendons, the drawing up and crippling of limbs. No doubt comparative studies such as this one would yield very interesting results in other areas of the repertory. In fact, the total rubrics are:

If we put the total Causticum mind picture together in one table after an analysis like this, it gets easier to fully appreciate how the remedy is prepared from the others in what can only be described as techniques “still under debate.” But the cause of Causticum cannot be given up, and indeed the remedy itself provokes somewhat idealistic, protective, and even anarchistic points of view among today’s chemists and remedy preparers. The table below shows Causticum less the common “ground floor” rubrics – this really consolidates the remedy pieces just discussed into a complete picture (underlined rubrics are single for Causticum):
