

## TIMIDITY: Bashful and Awkward (But Uniquely So) A Contrast and Comparison of Bar C, Nat M, Nux V, and Sil

These four remedies have a few other things in common along with bashfulness and awkwardness. There are delusions of dead people, phantoms, and fancies; Ailments from anger, anticipation, and emotions; Fear in a crowd, of evil, on hearing bad news, and of misfortune; problems with eyes, ears, teeth, sensation of a stone in the stomach, paralysis, weakness, emaciation and aversion to food and drink, aggravations after eating to satiety, and aggravations due to idleness (interestingly, only Nat Mur is conspicuously missing from the rubrics “Activity, Desire For” and “Occupation, Amel.” Nat Mur has fear of work.). All four remedies can be found in the general Sycosis rubric, declaring their ‘hidden’ talents, and are found in equal strength in the general Psora rubric.

So how does one differentiate? The remedies are hardly alike, so not all bashfulness or awkwardness is created equally. To discover what is unique, it is important to get underneath the general ideas of “bashful” and “awkward” to find aggravating and causative factors, fears and delusions. From these, one can then explore the various manifestations of the diseased state of each remedy within the context of their unique expressions of timidity.

In bold type under the rubric “MIND; Timidity”<sup>1</sup>, Baryta Carb believes people look at her and laugh, she thinks she is incapable and cannot succeed at anything, and she thinks she is ugly (all reasons why people would want to point at her and mock.). There is anger with cowardice accompanied by fear of people, crowds, open and narrow places, crossing bridges, and travel by rail. Baryta fears attempting anything and has a feeling of being ‘cut off at the knees’ (doomed to failure before starting.). Baryta children will hide themselves for fear visitors will laugh at them. They will hide behind mother’s skirt, or cover their eyes and peek through their fingers. There may be a history of having been over-protected. There is embarrassment. She cries because she has no friends. See Baryta Carb image and rubrics, Appendix A.

Found in italics, Natrum Muriaticum, appears shy and timid because she believes she will only be hurt again. After all, she has been hurt so many times (and she can recount every time in great detail). Her pride is hurt. She remembers and cannot forget, reliving all the hurt. She is mortified, indignant, ridiculed, slandered. Her timidity can be ameliorated by alcohol (and then she can be shameless in bed!) – Nat Mur is the only remedy whose timidity is ameliorated by alcohol. She is camera shy and does not want her picture taken because she believes she looks wretched and her pride will not allow a photograph. Her suppressed anger can paralyze her. See Natrum Muriaticum Image and rubrics, Appendix A.

Also in italics, Nux Vomica’s shyness and timidity can appear similar to Natrum Mur in related rubrics, but in Nux there is an extra effort here: fastidious, workaholic, better for being occupied, dictatorial; there is disappointment over loss of ambition. Both have loathing of life. Nux V becomes over-stressed and over-stimulated with hidden worries and fears, thinking of suicide but lacking in courage (a kind of shyness); the greater the fears, the greater the need to control and to be controlling. Nux V overtly demonstrates his greedy debauchery and anger in order to cover up his cowardice, timidity, and anxiety. The only remedy noted within four repertories for the delusion that he can live

without a heart, Nux V is aggravated by alcohol, other stimulants, and high “man-about-town” living. See Nux Vomica rubrics, Appendix A.

Finally, shown in bold type, Silica’s shyness and timidity appears in the mind as a stubbornness to hold onto his own ideas regardless of proof to the contrary. Their image is very important to them as are their own beliefs about the world and their environment. They will not stand their ground but will yield to others, all the while holding onto what they think or feel. They feel out of contact, disconnected, or ‘split in two.’ Their shyness is manifested in great weakness and withdrawal. See Silica Image and rubrics, Appendix A.

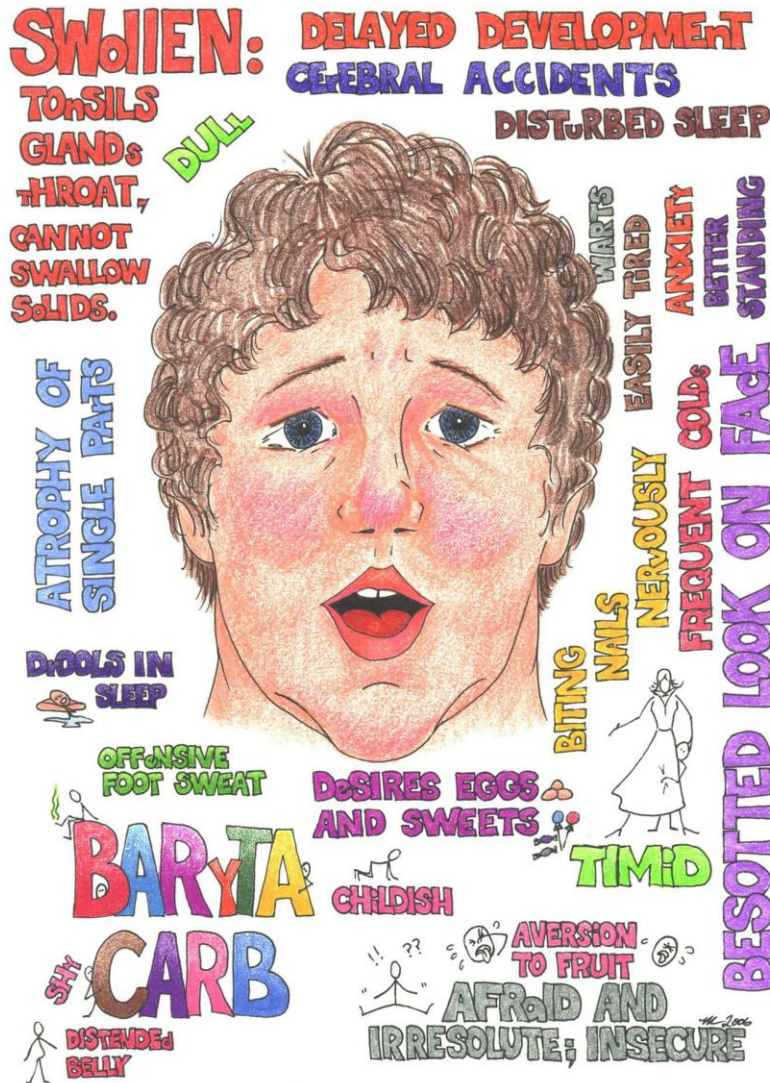

**Baryta Carb Timidity: Shy and Awkward**



Withered, dried up, sickly appearance; child is emaciated (adults often obese), shy, bashful, sits around uninterested and idle; child is backward, retarded, late in learning to walk and talk, poor muscular coordination; adults are irresolute and have a poor memory, forgets well-known names, are childish, gets lost in familiar surroundings; trifles frighten, worries that she is being laughed at; poor appetite.

Physical weakness with desire to lie down; a curious tendency to lipotamous (fatty) or fibrotic growths or nodules; takes cold easily; generally chilly. Chronic tonsillitis often moves to quinsy, accompanied by great difficulty in swallowing.

Weak digestion, discomfort after eating. Constipation associated with hard, knotty, inadequate stools; undigested matter may pass in the stools; urge to stool may be sudden and irresistible; enlargement of lymph and salivary glands is common, but without tendency to suppurate; skin often sensitive and tense, giving a "hide-bound" sensation.

Aggravated by cold, esp damp cold, also great heat or exposure to hot sun, when standing still, and by lying on left side; relieved by warmth, movement, open air.

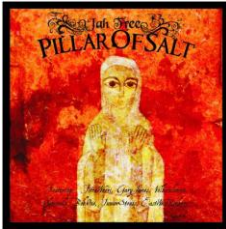

**Enlarged head out of proportion to body, emaciated appearance, distended or enlarged belly.**

**Anxiety from noise. Stage fright. Fear of pointed objects; pins.**

**Obstinate. Screaming when touched. Weep when reprimanded.**

**Failure to thrive in infants. Cannot assimilate nutrition; do not tolerate breast milk; lose weight. Tear duct styes in newborns.**

**Timid stool; difficult stool, straining; craving for sweets, ice cream, eggs; Aversion to mother's milk; rectal abscess; Dental abscesses; Acute/chronic ENT symptoms; Mastitis in nursing women; breast abscesses, nodules, fibroids; scoliosis; curvature, calcification, defects of the spine. Ingrowing toenails, bunions; Crippled nails; offensive foot sweat.**
